The construction sector is a crucial component of Poland's GDP, contributing over 151,856 mln PLN in 2021, which amounted to approximately 5.8% of Poland's total GDP.

WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT

Soundproofing

Poland is the world's largest exporter ofdoors and PVC windows. This is a dynamically growing category due to the thermal and acoustic insulation that such windows and doors provide. The exports of Polish windows and doors increased to 28 out of its 30 main destinations, making up for 29% of all European exports of these products in 2021.

Polish construction industry boasts a numer of the world's finest, eco-friendly solutions. They range from composite building materials made of PET bottles and prefabricates to energy-efficient ,passive' houses and smart home solutions.

How others see Poland

The Polish construction industry is highly regarded for its technical profficiency, talented specialists, great value for money and innovative solutions. This has been recognised by a number of high-profile foreign investors that have chosen to build their factories in Poland.

But Polish businesses are also eager to expand abroad, as is clearly shown in the form of both greenfield and M&A investments by such companies as Oknoplat, the Pietrucha group and Selena in such countries as Germany, Ukraine, Spain, the Philippines and Romania.

DID YOU KNOW THAT

Palaces and residences

The advanced energy-saving technology developed by the Polish company Izodom has been used in 3,000 residences built in the United Arab Emirates, as well as a 10,000m² Royal palace in Morocco.

Leaders in modular building

Walking down Sixth Avenue in New York you will soon find the world's tallest modular hotel, the Marriott. This 26-floor-high hotel had its modules manufactured by a Polish company DMDmodular and some experts have already acclaimed it a major architectural achievement. Another Polish manufacturer Polkon has recently been contracted to manufacture a prefebricated student hall of residence for Kampala University in Uganda. Their well-appreciated modules can be found in low-rise and high-rise buildings in Europe, Canada, the Carribean and on both the East and West coasts of the US.

Polish construction companies have been involved in a wide range of infrastructural projects all over the world, ranging from metro systems in Almaty and Saint Petersburg, Charkov's tram tracks to a rail bridge in Stockholm and a wastewater treatment plant in Riga, to name just a few.
